Toscolo Vernaccia di San Gimignano DOCG

The medieval town of San Gimignano is one of Tuscany's finest gems and its indigenous Vernaccia grape is said to be one of Italy's oldest, possibly going back to the third century B.C. It made history when, in 1966, Vernaccia di San Gimignano became Italy's first DOC wine. This is luminous straw yellow with an aromatic bouquet of white flowers, pear and honeysuckle, the palate fresh and lively with citrus and almond notes.

Toscolo Chianti DOCG

Brilliant ruby in colour, this all Sangiovese Chianti is supple, fruity and flavourful with appealing balance and that essential 'bite' that makes Chianti particularly food-friendly and versatile. Plus, it's a bargain.

Monte Antico IGT

A blend of 85% Sangiovese, 10% Merlot and 5% Cabernet, aged for 1 year on oak (80% Slavonian barrels, 20% in barrique). The colour is dark ruby with a bouquet of leather, earth, herbs, black cherries, liquorice and plums. The palate is medium bodied; round, spicy, elegant, attractively fruity and extremely versatile with any fare from pasta to meat, fowl and cheese.
