Enrico Coser, young gun winemaker from Ronco dei Tassi, created Clic to introduce a new generation to the delights of the grapes and wines of Friuli. The name Clic, in Friulan dialect, means 'a small glass of wine shared with friends' – exactly what the range is designed for. Great value wines with 'drinkability', bottled under screwcap with decidedly modern packaging.

The fruit is sourced from their own vineyard in Collio and from growers in the nearby Colli Orientali and Grave sub-regions. The fruit is picked early to maintain varietal freshness and keep the alcohol low.

Bianco IGT

A blend of 40% Chardonnay, 40% Friulano and 20% Riesling. The Chardonnay undergoes partial malolactic fermentation, adding body and richness; Friulano contributes pear, almond and zesty acidity; and Riesling lifts the aromatics and offers freshness on the palate. But, this is a wine that really is the sum of its parts, and together they highlight the textural notes atypical of the region's multi-varietal white wines.

Pinot Grigio IGT

Hot pink packaged pinot grigio, perfect for summer. Vinified in stainless steel, this is crisp and refreshing with good mid-palate weight and flavour of almond, green apple and hay.

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
